

UP LEKHPAL RECRUITMENT 2024

The Uttar Pradesh Lekhpal Recruitment 2024 (Up Lekhpal 2024) is an upcoming competitive examination conducted by Uttar Pradesh.

UP Lekhpal is a clerical vacancy in UPSSSC and the job of a Lekhpal is to report details to the revenue officer, maintain village revenue accounts and records, inspect fields, report amendments related to mutation and partition, modify official maps, to the survey, and provide assistance during natural disasters and agricultural crises. Uttar Pradesh Subordinate Services Selection Commission (UPSSSC) is inviting applications from interested and eligible candidates for the post of UP Lekhpal 2024. Application forms will be available online after the release of the official notification.

The authority will conduct An entrance examination to shortlist the applicants for Lekhpal posts in the Revenue Accounts and Land Records Department of Uttar Pradesh State. Candidates who want to get selected for this post should start preparing for the exam.

Eligibility Criteria for UP Lekhpal 2024

Uttar Pradesh Subordinate Services Selection Commission (UPSSSC) has set certain eligibility criteria that candidates must fulfil to become eligible for the UP Lekhpal selection process.

Below, candidates can check the basic eligibility requirements for the UP Lekhpal Exam 2024 –

Age Limit:

The minimum age limit to apply for the exam is 18 years.

The maximum age limit for UP Lekhpal is 40 years. Relaxation in the upper age limit has been provided to reserved category candidates.

Educational Qualification

Applicants must have passed 12th or higher secondary class with minimum qualifying marks from a recognized board.

Candidates must have a CCC certificate from NIELIT.

Domicile:

The candidate must be a domiciled resident of Uttar Pradesh.

Nationality:

The candidate must be an Indian citizen.

Selection Process for UP Lekhpal 2024

Candidates will be selected based on the PET exam (Preliminary Exam) and the Main Exam conducted by UPSSSC. Candidates have to appear in the PET exam first, and then qualified candidates have to appear in the UP Lekhpal Main exam.

Interested and eligible applicants who have applied for the UP Lekhpal Main Exam must have passed the 12th-level examination from a government-certified board.

Syllabus for UP Lekhpal 2024

A complete understanding of the UP Lekhpal Syllabus is very important while starting the preparation for the exam. Candidates who are going to appear in the UP Lekhpal exam can check the exam syllabus online by visiting the official website.

Candidates are advised to thoroughly read the syllabus and topics covered in the exam and start preparing themselves for the exam accordingly. Among the subjects included in the UP Lekhpal Syllabus, subjects like:

General Studies: Indian History, Indian Geography, Indian Polity, Indian Economy, and General Science.

General Hindi: Hindi Grammar, Hindi Vocabulary, Hindi Comprehension, and Hindi Essay Writing.

General Arithmetic: Number System, HCF and LCM, Fractions, Decimals, Percentage, Profit and Loss, Interest, Mensuration, and Ratio and Proportion.

Revenue Administration: Land Revenue System in India, Land Tenures, Land Records, Land Acquisition, and Land Reforms. Land Laws: Indian Easements Act, 1882, Indian Registration Act, 1908, and Transfer of Property Act, 1882.

UP Lekhpal 2021 Selection Process

This would be for the first time that the recruitment for **Lekhpal Group C** will be made entirely based on the written test. There will not be any interviews for this recruitment.

There will be a single written exam for the UPSSSC Lekhpal 2021. Earlier there used to be a written exam followed by an interview. But with this year there will be a single exam which will comprise of a written test consisting of Multiple Choice Objective Questions (MCQ's),

The UPSSSC Lekhpal exam is of 100 marks consisting of 100 questions. The UPSSSC Lekhpal paper will have 4 sections/ subjects. The written exam will be taken on OMR Sheet. There will be 25 questions in each sections which consists of 25 marks for each section. Candidates need to attempt the every section. There will be negative marking of 1/4 of the marks of the question.
