- Union Minister Jagat Prakash Nadda, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), inaugurated the 2nd edition of the Global Food Regulators Summit (GFRS 2024) held from 20th to 21st September 2024 in New Delhi, Delhi.
- This Summit was organized by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).
- The <u>6th State Food Safety Index (SFSI 2024)</u>, an annual report evaluating the food safety performance of Indian states and union territories was also released during the event.
- The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock (MAPA) of Brazil under the umbrella of Global Food Regulators Summit, 2024, at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi on 21st September 2024.  September, 2014 at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi, Delhi.
- It is being implemented by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry (MoC&I).
- India's FDI inflow has increased exponentially by 119%, from USD 304 billion (2004-14) to
 USD 667.4 billion (2014-24). This investment inflow spans across 31 states and 57 sectors,
 promoting growth across diverse industries.
- The Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme was launched in 2020 across 14 key
 manufacturing sectors, with budget allocation of Rs 1.97 lakh crores. The scheme aims to
 create 60 lakh new jobs and an additional production of 30 lakh crore during the next 5
 years.
- PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP), a strategic initiative of Government of India
 (GoI) launched on 13th October, 2021, aimed at achieving Aatmanirbhar Bharat and a USD
 5 trillion economy by 2025 through the creation of multimodal and last-mile connectivity infrastructure.
- On 30th September 2024, the MoC&I introduced the 7th Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP 2024) to further strengthen the Make in India initiative.

- CSIRT-POWER was developed to protect India's power infrastructure from cyber threats.
- The creation of CSIRT-Power was initiated as part of the 100-day initiatives of the MoP in collaboration with Indian Computer Emergency Response Team(CERT-In), following the National Cyber Security Policy, 2013.

- This is for the **3rd** consecutive quarter of FY25 that interest rate on SSSs remain unchanged.
- In December 2023, the Government of India (GoI)increased the interest rates of some of the small savings scheme such as: Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana (SSY) and 3-year Time Deposit, were increased by 20 basis points (bps) for O4FY24.
- The PPF rates have remained unchanged since April 2020. It was last changed in April-June 2020, when it declined from **7.9% to 7.1%**.
- SSSs are **savings instruments** managed by the GoI to encourage citizens to save regularly.
- The SSSs are broadly classified into 3 categories: savings deposits, social security schemes, and monthly income plan.

- The 8 new GI products include traditional food items and several unique varieties of rice beer reflecting the practices of the Bodo Tribe of Assam.
- The application for the GI tag for Jou Gwran; Maibra Jou Bidwi and Jou Gishi, the rice beer variants, were filed by the Bodo Traditional Brewers Association.
- Jou Gwran- This boasts the highest alcohol content at around 16.11% among rice beers by Bodo community.
- Maibra Jou Bidwi also called 'Maibra Jwu Bidwi' or 'Maibra Zwu Bidwi', this drink is cherished as a welcome beverage.
- Jou Gishi- It is another traditionally fermented rice-based alcoholic drink.
- Napham

 It is a fermented fish dish made anaerobically in a sealed container in a process
 that requires about two-three months.

- An amendment is made in sub-section (4) of Section 206C of the Act allowing parents to claim TCS credits when their minor child's income is included in the parent's taxable income.
- CBDT Notification No. 114/2024 amends Rule 37-I of IT Rules is also amended to enable TCS credits to be claimed by individuals other than the collectee, aligning with the new provisions.
